- On 30.11.2024, during Annual Prize Distribution Function, **Hon'ble Chief Minister** of the state **Sh. Sukhvinder Singh Sukhu** announced that the college will be named after Late Raja Virbhadra Singh, Hon'ble former Chief Minister of the state and very shortly notification was issued regarding it. All the formalities related to this issue have been completed by college administration in Feb. 2025 and now the college has been **named as Raja Virbhadra Singh Govt. College Seema**.
- In a significant step towards enhancing teacher education, **Hon'ble Chief Minister** announced the **introduction of the B.Ed. Course** at Raja Virbhadra Singh Government College Seema. The announcement was made in the esteemed presence of Sh. Rohit Thakur, Education Minister, and Sh. Mohan Lal Brakta, MLA of the constituency. This initiative aims to strengthen the education sector, provide aspiring teachers with quality training, and create better employment opportunities. The introduction of the B.Ed. program marks a milestone in the college's academic expansion, furthering its commitment to excellence in higher education.

BRIEF OVERVIEW OF THE COLLEGE:

(A) EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES AND COURSES OFFERED

1. UNDERGRADUATE LEVEL

Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA)

The Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) and semester system have been introduced from the academic session 2013-2014 by the State Government under RUSA. The main feature of the CBCS UG Courses is to make undergraduate education student centric and prepare them to compete locally, regionally, nationally as well as globally. Within CBCS, students have complete freedom to choose their subjects from a pool of subjects under **BA, B.Sc., B.Com. and BCA** as suggested by the UGC. As CBCS strives to create a holistic syllabus, therefore from the session 2016-2017, in addition to dedicated focus on a discipline through core paper, elective papers have been added. Besides, keeping in line with the vision of the Government, special emphasis has been given to Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC) and Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC).

The college received the notification to start a Bachelor Degree Course in **Business Administration** in the year 2012-13 and started the classes from the session 2019-20 and from the session 2021-22, **B.Voc. courses** are offered to the students in 'Hospitality and Tourism' & 'Retail Management'.

2. POST-GRADUATE LEVEL

The College provides **Post-graduation in English, Political Science and History** since July 2007-2008 and **in Hindi, Economics & Commerce** since 2017-2018. The strength has not only increased but also has given good results.

3. ADD-ON COURSES

Keeping in mind the cut-throat competitive scenario in employment sector, the college has been successfully running **four 'Add-on Courses'** since 2007-2008 in -

1. Functional English
2. Fashion Designing
3. Marketing Management
4. Tourism and Travel Management

4. COURSES UNDER PM KAUSHAL VIKAS YOJNA

In July 2024 **two courses** were introduced in the college under **PM Kaushal Vikas Yojna**. There are 30 seats in each course. These two courses are -

1. Data Entry Operator
2. Beautician

(B) INFRASTRUCTURAL FACILITIES

We have upgraded our infrastructure and are constantly in process of doing the same, so that our students find themselves second to none as far as exposure and modern facilities that supplement education are concerned. Our infrastructural facilities include: auditorium-cum-library, arts and science blocks, administrative block-cum-examination hall, hostels (boys and girls) with the capacity of 90 boys and 105 girls for hostel respectively, 5 computer labs, 180 computers, 8 smart-classrooms, conference hall, canteen, playground, gymnasium, and eco-friendly bio-toilets. A shooting range is also established in the college. **Extensive repairs and renovations** have been successfully completed in **16 washrooms of the girls' hostel** and safety wall using the college building funds. This improvement ensures better hygiene, sanitation, and living conditions for hostel residents, providing them with a clean and comfortable environment. The **staff quarters have undergone necessary repairs** and renovations, improving their overall condition. However, the electrical work is still pending, which needs to be addressed urgently to ensure proper living conditions for the faculty and staff.

(C) OTHER FACILITIES

- Facility of Wi-Fi, INFLIBNET, Biometric Machine and CCTV.
- A collection of **16,756 books**, out of which 11,475 are text books, 1112 are reference books and 443 books are in the community section. In addition to these we have 5 daily newspapers, 5 magazines and 5 journals. It also has an e-resource center. The college library through INFLIBNET (Information and Library Network Center of UGC) also provides online access to e-books, e-journals to teachers and students. In the previous session the process of installation of Library Management System was also carried out.
- **Water Purifiers and Coolers.**
- **Napkin vendors** machine in girls hostel.

(D) UNIQUE FEATURES AND BEST PRACTICES

- The **Donor's Account**, approved by the College Student's Central Association (CSCA), Parent-Teacher Association (PTA), and students, is a significant initiative aimed at providing financial assistance to orphans and underprivileged students. This collective effort ensures transparency, inclusivity, and active participation from all stakeholders in supporting those in need. By fostering a culture of generosity and social responsibility, the initiative strengthens the institution's commitment to equal educational opportunities and holistic student welfare. To foster this further, the principal of the college Dr. Lalita Rawat pays Rs. 1,000 on monthly basis. To sustain the account, it is also unanimously agreed upon by the staff, PTA and CSCA to include the fine of the students in the donor account. In the PTA meeting it was further decided that students would pay Rs. 100 during the admission and passing out from the college.
- The **introduction of Dress Code** by the college serves as a symbol of discipline, unity, and professionalism among students. It instills a sense of responsibility, encourages adherence to institutional values, and fosters a culture of respect and pride. By wearing blazers, students not only represent the college's identity but also develop a mindset of discipline that prepares them for future professional environments.
- The **decentralization of powers to Deans and Academic heads** enhances efficiency, accountability, and decision-making within the institution. By delegating authority, the college ensures smoother administration, faster resolution of academic and student-related matters, and improved governance. This approach empowers faculty leaders to address specific departmental needs effectively while maintaining overall institutional standards and objectives.
- The concept of "**Mera College, Mera Ghar**" aims to foster a deep sense of belonging and emotional connection among students, faculty, and staff, making the institution feel like a family. By instilling values of care, respect, and responsibility, this initiative encourages individuals to treat the college as their second home. It promotes teamwork, mutual support, and active participation in college activities, ultimately creating a nurturing and inclusive academic environment where everyone feels valued and motivated to contribute.
- College holds the distinction among the state colleges to have its **own Mahavidyalayagaan**: 'JaiJaiJai ho Seema Mahavidyalaya' composed by A.P. Chanchal Thakur (music vocal). It is sung on every important occasion.

- The college has been shortlisted for SwarnJayantiUtkrishtMahavidyalaya Yojana funded by Dept. of Higher Education H.P. and now holds the distinction of College of Excellence under this Scheme since 20th January 2023.
- **Center for Integrated Mountain Studies** with emphasis on Pabbar Valley and Adjoining Area of Shimla District was established on 14th March 2023 at RVS Govt. College Seema under SwarnJayantiUtkrishtMahavidyalaya Yojana.
- Pursuing its policy of reducing paper waste, the college took the initiative of **digital marking of students' attendance** from previous session.
- Every morning the **National Anthem** is played at 10:00 am; the entire college comes to a still in honour of our motherland daily.
