BRIEF OVERVIEW OF THE COLLEGE:**A) EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES AND COURSES OFFERED****1. UNDERGRADUATE LEVEL Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA)**

The Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) and semester system have been introduced from the academic session 2013-2014 by the State Government under RUSA. The main feature of the CBCS is to make undergraduate education student centric and prepare them to compete locally, regionally, nationally as well as globally. Within

CBCS, students have complete freedom to choose their subjects from a pool of

subjects suggested by the UGC. As CBCS strives to create a holistic syllabus, therefore from the session 2016-2017, in addition to dedicated focus on a discipline through core paper, elective papers have been added. Besides, keeping in line with the vision of the Government, special emphasis has been given to Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses and Skill Enhancement Courses.

The college also started a Bachelor Degree course in **Business Administration** from the session 2019-20 and from the session 2021-22 a three-year duration undergraduate B. Voc. course is offered to the students in 'Hospitality and Tourism' & 'Retail Management'.

2. POST-GRADUATE LEVEL

The College provides Post-graduation in English, Political Science, Hindi, Economics, Commerce and History. The strength has not only increased but also has given good results. Besides it, the self-financing course under the faculty of **PGCA** is also operational in this College.

3. ADD-ON COURSES

Keeping in mind the cut-throat competitive scenario in employment sector, the college has been successfully running **four "Add-on Courses" in Functional English, Fashion Designing, Marketing Management and Tourism and Travel Management.**

Along with this the college collaborated with HPKVN to start a Graduation Add-On Program for the final year students from the session 2021-22. In this program the students are trained to today's trends and to improve their soft skills and personality development. This additional program has a skilled staff and a proper lab with high standard teaching equipment.

These future-oriented and skill-based courses inculcate the virtues of self-confidence and competitive spirit which are definitely going to help our students to have an edge over the others.

B) INFRASTRUCTURAL FACILITIES

We have upgraded our infrastructure and are constantly in process of doing the same, so that our students find themselves second to none as far as exposure and modern facilities that supplement education are concerned. Our infrastructural facilities include: auditorium-cum-library, arts and science blocks, administrative block -cum- examination hall, hostels (boys and girls), four computer labs with 100 computers, conference hall, canteen, playground, gymnasium, and eco-friendly bio-toilets.

- Facility of **Wi-Fi, INFLIBNET, Biometric Machine and CCTV.**
- A collection of approx. **20,000 books**, out of which 15909 are text books, 124 are reference books and 7953 books are in community section. In addition to these we have six daily newspapers, 36 magazines

and journals. It also has an **e-resource center**. The college library through **INFLIBNET** (Information and Library Network Center of UGC) also provides online access to **e-books, e-journals** and online library to teachers and students.
